Bathroom

- Soap dish & toothbrush holder
 - Rug/Bath mat
- Shower organizer
- Garbage can & bags
 - Toilet paper
- Over the door hook
- Shower curtain & hooks (rod provided)
- Plunger

Kitchen

- Dishes, bowls, silverware, etc.
 - Pots and pans
 - Cooking utensils
 - Dish towels
- Paper towels and holder
- Garbage can and bags
- Small appliances (toaster, blender, can opener, etc.)

Bedroom

- Full size bed linens and pillows
- Clothes hangers
- Storage bins
- Desk lamp

Bedroom (Cont'd)

- Desk organizer & supplies
 - Alarm clock
- Garbage can and bags, recycling bin
- Curtains (mini blinds are provided), tension rod

Cleaning Supplies

- Vacuum cleaner/bags
- Mop, broom, dustpan
- Cleaners: All-purpose, tub and tile, glass cleaner, toilet cleaner
- Dishwasher soap, dish soap, sponges

Laundry

- Laundry basket
 - Laundry detergent, bleach
 - Iron
- Small ironing board

Other Items

- Renters insurance (optional but highly recommended)
 - Stereo (w/ headphones as to not disturb your neighbor)
- Surge protectors
- Coaxial/internet cords

Items to Leave at Home Part 1

- Extension cords (use surge protectors)
- Pets (except fish in tank under 10 gallons)
- Candles, incense or any type of flame-making device

Items to Leave at Home Part 2

- Darts
- Kerosene, propane or electric space heaters
- Waterbeds
- Oil or halogen lamps
- Illegal drugs and/or paraphernalia

Items to Leave at Home Part 3

- Unwillingness to compromise
 - Open-coiled heating units
 - Weapons (of any type)
- Multi-outlet plugs
